














### 3. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO TNJFU DEGREE COURSES

#### 3.1. B.F.Sc. & B.Tech. Courses

- Candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu State alone are eligible to apply. However, candidates from other states are eligible to apply for B.Tech. (Biotechnology) under the Other State Quota.
- A pass in the Higher Secondary Course in 10+2 pattern (State Board / CBSE / any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto) examination and fulfilling the following requirements are eligible.

Open Competition (OC)	55% aggregate of all the four required subjects

#### 3.2. B.B.A. and B.Voc. courses

- Candidates from any academic / vocational stream belonging to Tamil Nadu State are eligible to apply. However, other state candidates are eligible for B.B.A. (Fisheries Enterprises Management) only.
- A pass in the Higher Secondary Certificate (State Board / CBSE / any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto).

#### 3.3. Re-evaluation/Re-totaling

If revaluation/re-totaling results are published after the rank list, applicants must email revised marks to the Chairman, UG Admissions 2026-27 at **admissionug@tnfu.ac.in before counselling**. Claims after counselling will not be considered for rank revision. If revised marks are lower and admission was obtained based on original marks, the admission will be cancelled. Fresh allotment may be considered on request based on revised marks.

#### 3.4. Number of attempts

Maximum attempts to pass the qualifying exam: three for SC/SCA/ST and two for all other communities. **This condition does not apply to candidates applying for B.Voc. courses.**

### B. Vocational Stream (5%) - B.F.Sc. only

- i. Candidates who passed a Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) under the Vocational stream and studied Biology and Agricultural Practices as vocational subjects including theory and practical.
- ii. Candidates who passed a Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) under the Vocational stream and studied Biology, Agricultural Science – Theory, Agricultural Science – Practical and Computer Technology as vocational subjects.
- iii. Candidates who passed a Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) under the Vocational stream and studied Biology, Agricultural Science – Theory, Agricultural Science – Practical and Employability Skills as vocational subjects.

**Note:** Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) under vocational stream from other boards/ other states are NOT ELIGIBLE for admission in TNJFU.

#### 3.5.1. Aggregate mark calculation

$$\text{Aggregate mark} = \sum \left( \frac{\text{Marks obtained in each subject}}{\text{Maximum mark for that subject}} \right) \times 50$$

The aggregate calculation pattern followed for academic stream applicants shall also apply to vocational stream students. Marks obtained in all four eligible subjects will be converted to 50 marks each, and the aggregate mark will be calculated accordingly.

#### 3.5.2. Normalization of marks

As per Tamil Nadu Act No. 3 of 2007, dated 05.03.2007 and G.O. (Ms) No. HE (J2) Dept, dated 05.04.2007, the marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or Authorities shall be equated with the marks obtained by them in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the State Board of Tamil Nadu by adopting the method of normalization.

For example, if the highest mark secured in Physics by a Tamil Nadu State Board student is 100 and the highest mark secured by a student from another Board is 90, both will be treated as equivalent to 100%. If a student from the other Board secures 70 marks in Physics, while the highest mark in Physics in the Tamil Nadu State Board is 90, the 70 marks will be normalized to 77.78 marks of the Tamil Nadu State Board, as calculated below:

$$\frac{70}{90} \times 100 = 77.78\%$$

After the normalization of marks in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the other Board, the qualified students of different Boards shall be ranked in a common merit list. The common merit list will be prepared for the total marks of 200.

### 3.6. Age limit

Candidates applying for the above said courses (except B.Voc.) should not have completed the age mentioned below as on 01-07-2026.

- SC/SCA/ST candidates : No age limit
- Other candidates : 21 years
- Differently abled : 26 years

**Note:** There is no age limit to the candidates applying for 3-year B.Voc. degree courses.

### 3.7. Nativity

Candidates of Tamil Nadu Nativity only will be considered for general counselling. Tamil Nadu candidates who have not studied from 8<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> standards in Tamil Nadu should produce the Certificate of Permanent Residence in Tamil Nadu in the prescribed proforma (**Certificate I**) issued by the competent authorities. Candidates possessing a Community Certificate issued by the Government of Tamil Nadu need not submit **Certificate I**.

### 3.8. Physical Fitness

A certificate regarding the physical standards prescribed shall be obtained from the Government Medical Officer and produced at the time of admission.

### 3.9. RESERVATION

The reservations will be followed as per the orders of the Government of Tamil Nadu in vogue at the time of admission.

The list of communities eligible to compete against the reserved quota is furnished in **Appendix- I**.

Tamil Nadu Ordinance No. 4 of 2007 published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 262 dated 15.09.2007 provides for reservation in respect of annual permitted strength in each branch or faculty for admission into educational institutions in the State including private educational institutions. For the Backward Class Muslims it shall be three and a half percent within the thirty percent reservation for Backward Class as provided in the 1994 Act and in 2006 Act.

- a) Tamil Nadu native candidates alone will be considered for communal reservation. The community recorded in the certificate of Tamil Nadu native candidate should appear in the list of communities approved by the Government of Tamil Nadu (Appendix-I).
- b) The applicants from Tamil Nadu State should have obtained permanent Community Certificate in permanent card format/ electronic form/ digitally signed e-Certificate only from the authorities given below on or before the last date prescribed for submission of online application. Community Certificate obtained after the last date prescribed for submission of online applications will not be considered.

- c) Community Certificate obtained from other states will not be considered for communal reservation.
- d) For communities linked with Districts, the candidates should obtain their Community Certificate in the respective district except the communities mentioned in G.O. (ST) No. 95 BC, MBC & Minorities Welfare Department dated: 28.10.2009. Such of those Community Certificates obtained on or after 28.10.2009 will be considered. Community Certificates obtained from other than the respective district will not be considered.
- e) Candidates who have not produced the Community Certificate in the form of Permanent Community [Card] Certificate or electronic form / digitally signed e-Certificate at the time of original certificates verification, their application will be treated under "Open Competition (OC)". The candidate is further informed that in the event of such a decision, the eligibility conditions & rules prescribed for OC will be applicable for such candidates, and if such candidates do not satisfy the rules of OC, their applications are liable to be rejected. No correspondence in this connection will be entertained.

### 3.10. Special Reservations

Few seats are reserved (within the actual sanctioned strength) for **special categories** such as Differently-abled, Sports persons, Children of Ex-servicemen, Students studied at TN Government Schools and students from the vocational stream. The seats earmarked for the special categories will be allotted following horizontal reservation. The seats will be allotted as per the rank in the concerned special category and accordingly those seats will be deducted in concerned community. If adequate number of eligible candidates is not available under special category, then the earmarked unfilled seats will be reverted back to the **Academic General Category by duly following the State reservation policy.**

**Note: Campus transfer is not permissible for candidates admitted under special reservation quota on any account / circumstances.**

Since applications under special reservation categories require scrutiny by separate committees, candidates are instructed to produce the signed application form (generated after online submission) along with all necessary original certificates, supporting documents, and relevant appendices before the Chairman, UG Admissions, Tamil Nadu Dr. J. Jayalithaa Fisheries University, Nagapattinam, on the date specified by the University. The date of certificate verification will be communicated through the registered email ID and mobile number and will also be updated on the University website.

If the original certificates corresponding to the scanned copies uploaded online are not produced for verification, the claim under the respective special reservation category will not be considered. Candidates applying under special reservation categories will also be considered for general counselling in case of non-selection under the special category or if they are unwilling to join under that category. In such cases, the candidate must submit a request letter duly signed by the parent/guardian.

#### **i. Differently- abled**

Five percent (5 %) of the total number of seats is reserved for the differently-abled candidates. This reservation is provided only for the category of locomotor disability, low vision, hearing impairment, cerebral palsy, and specific learning disability are considered (USO.No.386/D1/TNJFU/UG Counselling/2024 & RC No. 3131/D1/TNJFU/ UG Counselling/2024 of the Registrar, TNJFU dated 30.05.2024).

Any other disability will not be considered. However, shall apply for Undergraduates degree programme under communal category. However, such candidates have to submit physical fitness certificate. The maximum age limit is relaxed to 26 years. The other conditions for admission to the courses are applicable as in the case of respective category.

The candidates seeking admission under this special category are expected to produce the necessary certificate from the **District Medical Board**, constituted to assess the nature and the extent of physical disability (locomotors disorders) in the format (**Certificate II**) prescribed in this prospectus. The medical certificate received without the specific recommendation of the District Medical Board will not be considered for selection under this special category. The candidate appearing for counselling will be physically examined by the medical officer/board specifically constituted for the purpose and **whose decision on eligibility is final**. The certificate has to be uploaded in the column specified.

The candidates who have previously applied for UG degree programmes under the differently-abled category and made ineligible by the Medical Board are not eligible to apply under this category. Such applications will be summarily rejected.

The differently-abled candidates of Tamil Nadu selected for admission will be exempted from paying **tuition fees** of the total admission fees prescribed by the University.

## ii. Eminent Sports Persons:

One seat for each of the degree programs in all constituent colleges is reserved for eminent sports persons. **This quota is not available for self-supporting courses.** The candidates of Academic Stream who wish to apply for B.F.Sc., B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering) degree courses under sports quota should have to upload their copies of the best-awarded certificates (Sports Meet / Tournaments / Competitions and secured I, II or III place and / or participated in individual events/ team games at the International / National/ State/District level) among last 4 years as per the table given (in application form) and upload their relevant sports certificates (not exceeding each 1 MB in PDF) at the time of filling the online application. The original certificates should be produced for verification at the time of counselling. In the event of a tie in sports marks, ranking will be determined based on the candidate's aggregate marks, followed by date of birth, with preference given to the elder candidate.

Note: Only one highest achievement in a year for the last four years will alone be considered. A candidate can list a maximum of FOUR highest achievements for a year. Selection of the candidate will be based on the sports marks obtained by following the Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu (SDAT) guidelines given in prospectus (Appendix II).

## iii. Children of Ex-Servicemen:

One seat for each of the degree programs in all constituent colleges is reserved for Children of Ex-Servicemen. **This quota is not available for self-supporting courses.** The candidates from Academic Stream, who wish to apply for B.F.Sc., B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering) degree courses under Children of Ex-Servicemen Quota should upload their relevant supporting documents (**Certificate III**, not exceeding **1 MB in PDF**) obtained from the Assistant Director of Ex-Servicemen Welfare Board of the District concerned that his / her father is an Ex-Serviceman and has served in the Armed Forces, when filling the online application. The original certificates should be produced for verification at the time of counselling.

## iv. Vocational Stream Candidates (5% B.F.Sc. only)

Five percent (5 %) of the total number of seats in B.F.Sc. degree course is reserved for the candidates studied under the Vocational Stream of HSC (**G.O.(Ms) No.206, dated 01.09.2022 of the Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (AU) Department**).

The candidates from the Vocational Stream shall be considered for admission to B.F.Sc. degree course only against the seats reserved for them and they will not be considered under any other categories. **However, they are eligible to apply to the B.B.A./ B.Voc. Programmes.**

**v. Students Studied from Tamil Nadu Government School:**

Seven and half percent (7.5%) of seats on "preferential basis" are reserved for students studied from Tamil Nadu Government schools in admission to professional courses such as B.F.Sc. / B.Tech.(Fisheries Engineering) / B.Tech. (Biotechnology) / B.Tech. (Food Technology) / B.B.A. (Fisheries Entrepreneurship Management). These students should have studied from Class VI to XII in the Tamil Nadu Government Schools.

Candidates who seek admission under this quota should furnish his/her EMIS number at the time of filling out the online application. The eligibility for admission under this quota will be verified by the Government of Tamil Nadu based on the EMIS number. Admission will be awarded only to the Government of Tamil Nadu-approved eligible applicants. Therefore, TNJFU will not hold responsibility for the mistakes made in the EMIS provided by the candidates at the time of application filling. The candidates who do not have an EMIS number should obtain and upload a bona fide certificate in the prescribed format provided in **Certificate IV**.

- "Government schools" mean and include Government schools, Corporation schools, Municipal schools, Panchayat Union schools, Adi-Dravidar and Tribal Welfare schools, Kallar Reclamation schools, Forest Department schools and other schools managed by Government departments.
- Student studied in Government schools shall also be entitled to compete for the Government seats, other than those set apart on preferential basis, along with the students who studied in private school.
- Admission of Students studied in Government schools on preferential basis shall be made by following the reservation as per the law in force.
- Notwithstanding anything contained in above, where adequate numbers of students studied in Government schools are not available for admission to the seats set apart on preferential basis, such unfilled seats shall be filled up with the students who studied in private schools.

**The seat allotment will be followed as mentioned in the GO (Ms) No. 167, Higher Education (J2) Department, dated 31.08.2021.**

**vi. Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) Quota for B.F.Sc. only:**

Fifteen percent (15%) of the total number of seats in B.F.Sc. degree course is allotted to **Fisheries College and Research Institute, Thoothukudi, Dr. MGR Fisheries College and Research Institute, Ponneri and Dr. MGR Fisheries College and Research Institute, Thalainayeru** for the candidates selected by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research through CUET (ICAR UG). The responsibility for the processes of admission and filling of vacancies lies with ICAR, and TNJFU does not bear any responsibility in this matter.

### vii. Sri Lankan Tamil Refugee students

Two seats are allotted to B.F.Sc. degree course for Sri Lankan Tamil Refugee students studied in Tamil Nadu shall be considered under **open competition**. Candidates applying under this special category should have to upload the following certificates (file not exceeding 1 MB in PDF) at the time of filling the online application. The original certificates should be produced at the time of counselling for verification.

- Identification certificate from Headquarters Tahsildar
- Those who have not registered in the Refugee camp should produce original passport, Visa and letter registered with police station.

### viii. Other State Quota

Fifteen percent (15%) of the seats are allotted for the other state candidates to study B.Tech. (Biotechnology) and BBA (Fisheries Entrepreneurship Management) degree programmes. **(U.S.O.No.306/S1/TNJFU/VIII AC/BOS (FBS)2018; RC.No.547/S1/TNJFU/ VIII AC/BOS(FBS) 2018; RC. No. 547/S1/TNJFU/VIII AC/BOS(FBS) 2018 dated 04.04.2018 & USO.No.234/B1/TNJFU/XIV AC/2021; Rc.No.4066/B2/ TNJFU/ XIV AC/2020 dated 11.03.2021 of the Registrar, TNJFU, Nagapattinam).**

### 4. Seats reserved over and above the admission strength (Supernumerary)

As per the **G.O.(Ms) No. 132, Animal Husbandry, Dairying, Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare (FS4) Department, dated 08.12.2021** the seats reserved over and above the admission strength will be filled.

**Note: Upward movement not applicable for Supernumerary seats.**

#### 4.1. Fishermen Ward (5 & 15%)

##### **Fishermen Wards (5%): 6 seats for B.F.Sc. and 2 seats for B.Tech. (FE):**

The candidates will be considered for admission in the following order of priority, irrespective of their cut-off marks. If more than one application in the same category is received, then the selection will be made based on the cut-off marks obtained by the candidates.

- Wards of fishermen whose father was shot dead while fishing, including by forces of another Country
- Wards of fishermen who were injured and disabled in accidents while fishing

- c) Wards of fishermen who have lost both parents
- d) Wards of fishermen who have lost their father only
- e) Wards of fishermen in cases where either one of their parents is a member of the Tamil Nadu Fishermen Welfare Board

Candidates applying under Fishermen ward special category should upload their relevant supporting documents like Community Certificate, TNFWB membership ID card and priority certificate/document (for S.No. a, b, c or d, if any) etc. (file not exceeding 1 MB in PDF) at the time of filling the online application. The original certificates should be produced at the time of counselling for verification. They should invariably upload their parents' membership in the Tamil Nadu Fishermen Welfare Board.

**Note: Semester fee, Hostel fee and Mess fee for the candidates admitted under 5% Fishermen Ward Special Category will be borne by Tamil Nadu Fishermen Welfare Board (TNFWB) (G.O.(Ms) No. 166, Animal Husbandry, Dairying, Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare (FS4) Department, dated 20.02.2017).**

#### **4.2. Fishermen Wards (15%):**

Candidates applying under 15% Fishermen ward special category should have to upload their Community Certificate (file not exceeding 1 MB in PDF) at the time of filling the online application. The original certificates should be produced at the time of counselling for verification. The selection will be made based on cut-off marks obtained by the candidates.

(Fisheries Engineering) degree programmes under merit basis for the Ward of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmir Valley **(U.S.O.No.1007/B2/TNJFU/XIV AC/2020; RC.No.4066/B2/TNJFU/XIV AC/2020 dated 05.01.2021 of the Registrar, TNJFU, Nagapattinam)**. The students for this quota will be admitted by the Government of India.

#### 4.4. Students of Andaman & Nicobar Islands

Seven seats are allotted to the students of Andaman & Nicobar (USO.No.019/R9/TNJFU/XIII AC/Edn./A.13.4.04/2019; Rc.No.5979/R9/TNJFU/XIII AC /Edn./A.13.04.04/2019 dated 08.01.2020 of the Registrar, TNJFU, Nagapattinam). The students for this quota will be admitted by the Andaman and Nicobar Government.

### Study in India (SII) portal

Students applying under the Foreign National category for B.F.Sc. and B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering) courses in Tamil Nadu Dr. J. Jayalalithaa Fisheries University, Nagapattinam – 611 002 should also apply through the **Study in India portal**.

Study in India (SII) portal <https://studyinindia.gov.in/> was launched by Ministry of Education (MOE), Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) and Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) on 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2023. It is a dedicated website for university admission and visa applications for foreign students who wish to pursue their higher education in Indian Higher Education Institutes (HEIs). With the launch of the portal, it is now mandatory for international students seeking admission in Indian HEIs to register on the SII portal for the academic session 2023-24 onwards for every full-time or short-term course. The portal provides a structured mechanism to facilitate foreign students to meet their visa obligations. A unique ID will be generated when a student register on the portal and this ID will have to be quoted with Visa applications.

### 4.7. B.F.Sc. (Self-supporting mode)

Twenty (20) seats are allotted for B.F.Sc. degree programme under self-supporting mode for the constituent colleges.

The candidates selected under self-supporting mode have to pay the **self-supporting fee of Rs. 75,000/-** (Rupees seventy-five thousand only) per semester over and above the regular fee.

### 4.8. Transgender (Supernumerary)

One supernumerary seat is allotted for transgender persons in each UG programme offered by the University, including B.F.Sc., B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering), B.Tech. (Food Technology), B.Tech. (Biotechnology), BBA (Fisheries Enterprises Management), and all B.Voc. courses.

## 5. INSTRUCTIONS TO FILL ONLINE APPLICATION

Instructions to Candidates from Tamil Nadu and Other States for Filling, Uploading Relevant Documents/Certificates, and Submitting Applications:

1. Candidates should carefully read the Prospectus before filling up the application form online. All rows / columns in the application should be correctly and completely filled in.
2. Candidates should submit applications **online** at <https://admission.tnjfu.ac.in> **on or before 14.06.2026, 6.00 PM. ONLY ONLINE APPLICATION WILL BE ACCEPTED. OTHER FORMATS OF APPLICATION WILL SUMMARILY BE REJECTED.**
3. Candidates should apply for B.F.Sc., B.Tech., B.B.A. and B.Voc. degree programmes through a single online application, provided they have paid the application/registration fees through online as detailed below, before applying.

4. Candidates applying under Other State Quota application fee is Rs.500/-.
5. If, for any reason (for want of more details), the candidate is not able to fill in all the required columns at a stretch, he / she may SAVE the application for future access. Upon saving the application, the candidate can login by entering their e-mail / mobile number and password (One Time Password - OTP) for editing the contents later and submission before the due date.
6. After filling in all the relevant columns in the application and uploading necessary documents / certificates, the candidates may recheck the details provided by them before submission through PREVIEW.
7. Candidates should ensure that the correct amount of ONLINE APPLICATION FEE is paid by using the method viz. a) Credit Card b) Debit Card c) Internet Banking d) IMPS and e) UPI in the ONLINE PAYMENT GATEWAY.

8. After the online submission of application and uploading necessary documents / certificates, the candidate will receive an SMS and email that his / her application is submitted successfully.
9. After the receipt of this SMS / email, the candidates may take a printout of the application for their reference. Candidates not receiving the SMS / e-mail even

after 48 hours post-submission may contact the Admission Committee through email **admissionug@tnfu.ac.in**.

10. The scanned copies of certificates/documents to be uploaded for online application are HSC / CBSE / other equivalent mark sheet, copy of Transfer Certificate, copy of Community Certificate, relevant Certificates for Special categories (if required) and copy of Nativity Certificate (if required).
11. **Community Certificate** is subject to verification by the District Vigilance Committee of the district concerned and if the community of the candidate is found to be untrue, admission is liable for cancellation besides criminal action being taken.
12. **No correspondence will be entertained in any form.**

**Important Note:** The contents in the application form and prospectus are subject to modification or revision that may be issued from time to time by the University and Government of Tamil Nadu.

### 5.2. Verification of Application and Release of Rank List

- The candidates will be given a time frame for verification and editing of the application after closure of the application submission date.
- Provisional Rank list for all the eligible applicants will be published through the Tamil Nadu Dr. J. Jayalalithaa Fisheries University web portal.
- Three days will be given for redressing the grievances after releasing the rank list.
- Grievances redressal will be through official UG Admission Committee email (admissionug@tnfu.ac.in). Final rank list will be published after addressing the grievances, if any.
- After release of the final rank list no changes will be entertained in the rank list.
- The rank list for admission to B.F.Sc., B.Tech., B.B.A. and B.Voc. degree programmes will be published in the University website - **<https://www.tnifu.ac.in>**.

### 5.3. Determination of the *inter se merit*

In cases where more than one student has got the same aggregate marks in the general rank list, the inter se merit among such students shall be determined in the order of priority as specified below (G.O. (Ms.) No.191 (AP.6) Department dated 16.05.2007).

## **5.4. MODE OF SELECTION**

The candidate has to fill their choice of degree course and college at the time of filling their application. Selection process is done through online and/or offline counselling only on merit basis. All candidates are required to pay a counselling fee before attending the Online/Offline counselling. **Calling for in-person counselling does not guarantee a seat.** Candidates will be selected on the basis of their

Aggregate Marks for B.F.Sc./B.Tech. and percentage marks for B.B.A./B.Voc. in the qualifying examination (HSC). The counselling process may be conducted either in online or offline mode, as decided by the University based on administrative considerations and operational convenience at the time of counselling.

#### 5.4.1. ONLINE COUNSELLING

After the release of rank list, shortlisted candidates will be informed through SMS and e-mail. The ratio of candidates shortlisted for participating in the online counselling will be decided by TNJFU based on the number of applicants and vacancies.

- During online counselling, the candidates will be allotted a Degree and College, based on their rank, community, and choice preferences made by them at the time of submission of online application.
- Online counselling system will be followed for all Degree programmes, **except special categories (Differently abled, 7.5% Government School, Ward of Ex-servicemen, Eminent Sports Person, NRI, Fishermen ward 5% and 15%)**.
- Selection process for general reservation candidates is done **through online counselling**. Online counselling will be conducted in several rounds based on the vacancy and candidates will participate in corresponding rounds based on their rank. Each round will have 4 stages.
  - a. Payment of counselling fee
  - b. Allotment
  - c. Confirmation of allotment and payment of admission fee through online
  - d. Reporting to University with original certificates for verification

A candidate will be given three days for choice filling wherein, the candidate will have to exercise their choices of colleges and degrees based on their preferences. The order of choices is important and a candidate can exercise multiple choices. Candidates' allotment will be based on the preferential order of choices according to their rank, community and availability of seats.

During allotment stage, if a candidate is allotted a seat, then the following four options will be shown as mentioned in the **Table 1**. The candidate must confirm the seat within 3 days from the date of allotment. Non-confirmation of the allotted seat by the candidate will lead to loss of his/her seat and the candidate will not be moved to the next round.

#### **CALLING FOR ONLINE COUNSELLING DOES NOT GUARANTEE A SEAT**

- Shortlisted candidates must register and pay the counselling fee for attending the online counselling through their individual login credentials (<https://www.tnjfu.ac.in>). Those who fail to register will not be considered for online counselling.

candidate, merit and communal reservations. The allotment will be informed to the candidates through SMS and e-mail. Detailed instructions on Admission fee payment, downloading of the Allotment letter and documents required for verification will be informed through registered email.

- After the online counselling, candidates will be called for certificate / document verification (**Appendix III**). After certificate/ document verification, the candidates have to submit their original certificates to confirm the seat allotted to them.
- **Before appearing for certificate verification, the candidates are required to pay an amount of Rs. 10,000/- towards admission fee by online mode within the stipulated period.** Only on successful payment of admission fee, the allotment letter can be downloaded. This amount will be adjusted in their first semester fee. Paying the admission fee does not guarantee the confirmation of seat. Confirmation will be done only after the verification of certificates / documents. Provisional admission card will be issued after successful verification
- The admission fee (Rs.10,000/-) is **REFUNDABLE if the candidate has not registered the first semester of the degree program** before closure of the admission by the University
- If any information (Marks, Qualification, Community, Date of Birth, Nativity etc.,) is found incorrect, the candidature will summarily be rejected. Delay in or failure to submit certificates/documents and pay the fees will result in cancellation of the seat
- Candidates of Tamil Nadu nativity, who have applied for any one of the special reservations are also eligible for general counselling
- **MERE REGISTRATION IN THE ONLINE COUNSELLING DOES NOT ENSURE SELECTION / ADMISSION OR ANY OTHER RIGHTS TO THE CANDIDATES SO REGISTERED**
- The detailed online counselling schedule and instructions for both General / Special categories will be hosted in the **TNJFU official website** later and the candidates are requested to keep checking the website regularly for the counselling particulars and updates

#### **5.4.2. IN-PERSON COUNSELLING**

In-person counselling for the academic stream and special reservation categories viz., Eminent Sports Person, Differently Abled, Wards of Ex-servicemen, Transgender will be conducted first in physical mode. Followed by the vocational counselling, 7.5% seats on preferential basis to the students who have studied 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> in state government schools, counselling for supernumerary seats viz., fishermen ward 5% & 15%, NRI and Transgender will be conducted through physical mode.

**Candidates attending special reservation counselling have to bring the necessary original document / certificate pertaining to their special reservation.** If necessary valid / original documents are not produced by the candidates during the counselling, they will not be allowed to attend the counselling process.

Candidates can choose the degree and college, based on their rank during in-person counselling, attendance of candidates will be marked both at the entry and exit. Candidates have to opt for a degree and college available at the time of counselling as mentioned in the Table 1. **DEGREE AND COLLEGE CHOICE ONCE MADE IS FINAL AND CANNOT BE CHANGED.** Candidates who have attended counselling and did not select any choice will be not considered for future counselling phase in the academic year. **CALLING FOR COUNSELLING DOES NOT GUARANTEE A SEAT.** TA and DA will not be given for attending counselling.

**Candidates who fail to attend the counselling at the specified date and time will forfeit their right to admission.** However, due to unforeseen and unavoidable reasons, if a candidate is unable to attend the counselling on the specified date and time, the candidate can authorize their parent/ guardian on their behalf and the parent's/ guardian's decision will be binding and final. Such authorization letter should bear photographs of the candidate and authorized person (candidate's parent / guardian) and signed by both the candidate and authorized person. The authorized person attending the counselling on behalf of the candidate should carry the counselling letter and photo ID proof. The format for authorization letter is provided in **Appendix IV.**

#### **5.4.3. UPWARD MOVEMENT SYSTEM**

- When vacancy arises, based on the choice exercised and willingness expressed for upward movement, during subsequent counselling, candidates will be moved to their best preferred upward choice of Degree and College based on merit and communal reservation.
- Upward movement system will be followed for all counselling based on arising vacancy. Non reporting and non-payment of admission fee will be considered as not willing to join and the allotment order will be cancelled. Such candidate will lose the allotted seat and will not be considered for further rounds of counselling.

### 5.5. SPOT ADMISSION

Spot admission is an offline counselling process. **Spot admission is applicable only for the vacant seats in the self-supporting courses, vocational degree courses, and B.F.Sc. in the affiliated private college.** For spot admission, counselling fee will be collected only from the candidates who avail a seat. After selection, the candidate must pay the counselling fee as prescribed above.

The announcement of spot admission will be done ten days before the closure of admission. The vacancy position, college-wise and community-wise will be published on the website and also in dailies for a larger reach. Candidates will be called in a ratio of 1: 10 or more depending on the situation. Applied candidates who have not attended the counselling earlier or those who have called for the spot admission can attend the counselling. Attendance will be marked and a ranking of attended

candidates will be done. Candidates will be called based on their rank for choosing the college and seat. Selected candidates must join the college immediately by submitting the educational certificates and **by paying an admission fee of Rs. 10,000/- on the day of spot admission.**

**CALLING FOR SPOT ADMISSION DOES NOT NECESSARILY GUARANTEE A SEAT.** No candidate will be admitted after the announcement of "Completion of Admission" for the academic year.

If any management seat falls vacant due to migration of students from the management quota seat to the counselling quota, the management is at liberty to fill up such vacancies within five days of the closure of TNJFU admission from the rank list provided by TNJFU on merit basis.

### **5.6. General instructions for admission under management quota in the affiliated college**

The affiliated college must adopt all guidelines issued by the Government in its affiliation order. TNJFU shall not be held responsible for the deviations committed/done by an affiliated institution in the adoption of prescribed Government guidelines.

The responsibility of verifying the candidate's eligibility for admission solely rests with the affiliated college. TNJFU is not liable for answering legal queries for discrepancies or deviations, if any. However, the original certificates of the candidates admitted by the affiliated college will be verified by TNJFU and if the candidate does not satisfy the eligibility as per the eligibility criteria as mentioned **in section 3.5**, his / her candidature will not be considered even at a later stage. All seats filled in under the management quota are subject to the approval of TNJFU.

The affiliated private college can admit only the applicants who have applied to TNJFU to fill their Management Quota seats.

#### **5.6.1. Minority Institution**

Fifty percent of the seats are filled through general counselling conducted by the University, while the remaining fifty percent are filled by the respective managements. Minority institutions shall fill their management quota seats in accordance with Government norms.

\*The minority status of institution is subject to Government approval.

## **6. SYSTEM OF EDUCATION**

The medium of instruction is English in all constituent colleges and evaluation pattern in the University is "Semester Course Credit System". All UG courses (except vocational courses [6 semesters]) are of 8 semesters (4 years) duration.

The e-learning initiatives in TNJFU necessitate the use of laptops/tablets for learning as well as for assignments. Admitted candidates may have a laptop/tablet throughout their courses of study.

## **7. FEE AND DEPOSITS**

Each selected candidate is expected to pay the following tuition fees, special fees, etc., as prescribed by the University from time to time in addition to the counselling fee.

## 7.2. Fee for Affiliated Private College (Minority Institution)

Candidates admitted through counseling and management quota in the St.Devasahayam Institute of Fisheries Science and Technology, Midalam has to pay an all- inclusive, annual Tuition Fee of Rs. 50,000/- as fixed by the Government of Tamil Nadu (G.O. (Ms.) 233 of Agriculture (AU) department dated 8.10.2020).

## 8. TUITION FEE CONCESSION

### 8.1. First Graduate Tuition Fee Concession

As per the G.O. (Ms) No. 85 Higher Education (J2) Department, dated 16.04.2010, the Government has ordered to grant tuition fee concession to the candidates, who are to be the first graduate in a family. Those who are attending counselling and joined in professional courses in Government Colleges, have to submit the following certificates for available tuition fee concession.

- (i) Certificate obtained from Headquarters Deputy Tahsildar in the form prescribed in G.O. **(Certificate - V)**.
- (ii) The candidates have to furnish **Certificate - VI** (Joint Declaration).

**If the brother or sister of the candidate has already availed First Graduate Tuition Fee concession for studying Professional Courses, then the applicant is not eligible for such concession.**

### 8.2. Government School Students full fee concession

As per the GO 221 Higher Education (J2) Dated 15.11.2021, the government of Tamil Nadu will bear the expenses for education in professional courses of students admitted under the 7.5% reservation for government school students. They have to submit proof for Government School study details from the Sixth Standard to the Twelfth Standard. The following categories of schools are classified as Government schools.

- Government Schools
- Government Corporation Schools
- Government Municipal Schools
- Government Forest Schools
- Government Adi Dravida and Tribal Welfare Schools
- Government Kallar Reclamation Schools

## 9. Scholarships/Fellowships

Scholarships such as SC / SCA / ST Welfare and Backward Class Scholarships, Scholarships given by Government of India, Government of Tamil Nadu and Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Pattukottai Azhagiri Endowment Scholarship, Pudhumaipen Scheme, Tamil Pudhalvan Scheme and scholarships from other agencies and financial assistance from Tamil Nadu Agricultural Labourers - Farmers (Social

Security and Welfare) Scheme are available for the deserving candidates admitted under Tamil Nadu state quota. The scholarship may vary according to the degree/college to which the candidates are admitted and respective funding agencies.

The candidates should furnish copies of **certificates (V and VI)** to the effect that he / she is the first graduate in his / her family from the appropriate authority along with the application. If the information furnished by him / her is found incorrect at a later stage, he / she will repay the entire amount spent on him / her by the Government, besides legal action being initiated against him / her.

### **9.1 Post Matric Scholarship**

#### **a) SC / SCA / ST students**

In the G.O. (Ms.) No. 6 Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare (AD3) Department dated 09.01.2012; G.O. (Ms.) No. 92 Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare (AD3) Department dated 11.09.2012; and G.O. (Ms.) No. 16 Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare (AD3) Department dated 24.02.2014, the Government has ordered to grant Post Matric Scholarship to SC / SCA / ST candidates and SC / SCA converted Christians, whose parental annual income is **less than Rs. 2,50,000/-** from all the sources shall only be eligible. The eligible candidates have to submit income certificate obtained from the appropriate authorities.

#### **b) BC / MBC / Minorities students**

In the G.O. (Ms.) No. 68 BC, MBC & Minorities Welfare Department dated 18.11.2021, the Government has ordered to grant Post Matric Scholarship to BC / MBC / Minority candidates, whose parental annual income is **less than Rs. 2,50,000/-** from all the sources shall only be eligible. The eligible candidates have to submit income certificate obtained from the appropriate authorities.

### **10. HOSTEL FACILITIES**

- a) Hostels for the students are available in each major campus and the messes are run on a dividing system
- b) The students will be accommodated in the hostels to the extent possible, subject to the availability
- c) A sum of Rs.10,000/- will be collected as hostel deposit (Refundable)

### **11. PAYMENT OF FEES AND REGISTRATION AFTER SELECTION AND ADMISSION**

A candidate, who has been selected for admission to undergraduate degree course, has to pay the semester fees and hostel deposits on or before the date of commencement of the classes at the respective colleges. Refund of fees will be done as per the UGC guidelines and TNJFU ASR&R.1.1.9 till the closure of admission.

## 12. REPORTING TO ADMITTED COLLEGES

Newly admitted students should report to the allotted college in time as indicated in the admission letter, failing which their admission will be cancelled. No exemption or permission will be entertained in this regard.

## 13. DISCONTINUING FROM THE DEGREE COURSES

Students who are unable to continue the course for genuine reasons such as

1. Inability to pay the fees,
2. Getting Government jobs for their SSLC / HSC qualifications,
3. Becoming physically handicapped during study and similar genuine cases will be permitted to discontinue. **All other cases who desire to leave the degree programme after the closure of UG admission (2026-27) or on any date of subsequent years irrespective of the fact should pay a sum of Rs. 2.00 lakhs.**

The selected candidates and his /her parent/guardian will have to execute an agreement bond (**Appendix V & VI**) during admission. Failure to execute the agreement bond will lead to cancellation of selection.

## 14. PREVENTION OF RAGGING

Ragging is punishable as per Proceedings of the Supreme Court of India in SLP (C) No. 24295/2004 conveyed by the University Grants Commission, vide Letter No.F.1-8/2006 (Cpp-II) dated: 04.03.2008. **If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be directed to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority will expel him/her from the Institution and liable for legal action.**

## 15. CORRESPONDENCE WITH TNJFU

## **16. DISPUTE REDRESSAL**

With respect to the interpretation of the provisions of any matter not covered in this prospectus, the decision of the University shall be the final and binding on all the parties concerned. Any complaints, grievances etc., related to UG admissions and academic matters must be first referred to the Chairman, UG Admission Committee, Tamil Nadu Dr. J. Jayalalithaa Fisheries University, Nagapattinam will be the appellate authority with respect to such complaints/ disputes. The Courts having their jurisdiction at Nagapattinam alone can adjudicate on all matters and disputes related to admissions and academic matters. Further, any legal question arising out of the admission shall be entertained only when raised within 30 days from the declaration of the result. No disputes will be entertained after the closure of admission.

The Private college affiliated to TNJFU are not authorized to admit any candidate against the seats allotted under the government quota of 65% as the case may be without specific prior approval of the Government of Tamil Nadu and TNJFU. TNJFU is not liable and legally binding for any admissions made under the lapsed seats violating the rules and regulations prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu/TNJFU for the admission of the candidates under government quota seats. The candidate admitted without the University approval and violating the above rule, will not be treated as students of TNJFU and cannot claim any right from TNJFU.

TNJFU will not be responsible for the return of the certificates, or any fee remitted by the candidates admitted under the Management Quota by the private college affiliated to TNJFU. Nothing is binding for TNJFU for any of the legal issues raised by the students admitted under Management Quota against the affiliated private college, related to issues of certificates, fee remitted etc.

National tournaments should have been officially be recognized as the regular annual championship / tournament by MYAS or IOA or SAI or SDAT or SGFI Nationals conducted every year by school education department in age groups (U-14, U-17, U-19) or respective official National Sports Federation will be considered (for each year) for the award of marks.

2. The candidates participated in the tournament conducted by CBSE, ICSE/ISC and KV Schools, at Regional / South Zone are equated to Regional Level Achievements, and the National Level Achievements are equated to State Level of State/ Matric Board Schools.

National or State Level Championships or Tournaments conducted by Sports Federations or Associations recognized by MYAS or IOA or SDAT or TNOA alone will be considered for the award of marks. (Recognition of State Associations / National Federations should be relevant to the year concerned).
  3. Relevant attested copies of certificates issued by the competent authorities as detailed below are to be submitted along with the application before the last date for receiving the applications.
  4. **Invitational or Memorial or any indifferent nomenclature or title of tournaments or Private Non-affiliated or Championships at District or State or National or International level will not be considered for marks.**
  5. District or Inter-District Championship means the championships conducted by the respective recognized District or State Sports Association for the State of Tamil Nadu.
  6. Direct participation or achievement at any level without participating in the qualifying level competitions such as District or State or National or direct selection conducted by District or State Sports Association or National Sports Federation to represent the District or State or National or International tournaments or championships will not be considered for award of marks.
  7. For International achievements in Tennis, marks for Gold, Silver and Bronze will be awarded to players who are ranked first, second and third respectively in the ATP or WTA rankings of International Tennis Federation for awarding participation marks for the top 5 ranked players will be considered from the ATP or WTA list published by the International Tennis Federation. Necessary document and proof should be enclosed by the candidate for National or State level achievement in Tennis, marks for Gold, Silver and Bronze will be awarded to players who are ranked first, second and third respectively in the AITA or TNTA at National or State for awarding participation mark the top 5 ranked players will be considered from the list published by AITA or TNTA at National or State level based on the ranking. Necessary documents and proof should be enclosed by the candidate.
  8. Certificates should be in printed form and necessary Form–I and II should be in prescribed format. (Certificates or forms issued in letter pads will be invalid).
  9. All other sport disciplines in which ranking is the criteria for assessment of achievement, rules indicated in item 8 above will be applicable for the award of marks.

10. For Cricket, the annual official Championships or tournaments conducted within the country under the auspices of TNCA or BCCI at District or State or National Level alone will be taken into consideration for that year.
11. Multiple events in a particular sport must be standardized events and in accordance with the events organized by the approved International Federations. Events newly created and not in accordance with the requirement will not be considered for award of marks.
12. Participation or achievements of candidates with nativity of Tamil Nadu who represented Tamil Nadu alone are eligible for marks under National Category.
13. Tamil Nadu Native students studying in abroad shall be eligible for award of marks, provided their sports certificates indicate representation of a district in Tamil Nadu at the district level, representation of Tamil Nadu at the national level, and representation of India at the international level.
14. Only Tamil Nadu candidates are eligible to apply for admission under Sports Quota and only the KVS CBSE and ICSE/ISC schools within Tamil Nadu are eligible for marks.
15. Tamil Nadu Native students studying in other state will be eligible for awarding marks, provided their sports certificates reflect representation of a district in Tamil Nadu at the district level, representation of Tamil Nadu at the national level, and representation of India at the international level.
16. A Common Committee constituted for this purpose will rank the candidates based on the marks assigned to the certificates enclosed along with the application.
17. All the achievement certificates are to be supported necessarily by the relevant participation certificates and appropriate forms.
18. Highest achievement or participation certificates obtained by candidates at different levels such as District or State or National or International in each year along with earlier achievements should be enclosed without fail. (A candidate shall enclose a copy of all eligible certificates for scrutiny).
19. Candidates in proportion to the available seats will be called to appear before the Committee for verification of the Originals, followed by counseling after ranking.
20. If any candidate fails to produce the requisite Original Certificates or Forms, his/her place will be allotted to the candidate next in rank and so on. The consequential vacancy at the end of the rank list will be filled up from among the additional candidates according to their ranks.

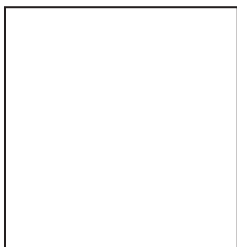
